EFTA-RELATES 2025 aims to be a dialogical and participative event, where people interact, discuss and share. Here are some ideas on how to incorporate an interactive approach to your presentation.

Pre-Event Engagement:

- Use surveys to gather questions or challenges from attendees.
- Share resources (papers, videos) for pre-reading to encourage discussion.

Interactive Formats:

- Live audience Q&A in panels.
- Roundtable discussions in smaller groups.
- Fishbowl method for dynamic exchanges.

Technology Integration:

- Tools like Mentimeter for live polling and feedback.
- Collaborative platforms (Miro, Google Docs) for co-creation.
- Audience-driven sessions using voting tools.

Active Learning & Gamification:

- Case studies and problem-solving in teams.
- Role-playing scenarios for real-world issues.
- Science trivia or hackathons with competitive elements.

Networking and Collaboration:

- Speed networking with time limits.
- Poster walks with guided discussions.

Inclusivity and Accessibility:

- Captioning, translations, and multiple engagement modes for accessibility.

Post-Event Follow-Up:

- Online forums for ongoing discussion (e.g., Slack).
- Collaborative white papers based on event contributions.

Creative Content Delivery:

- Flipped lectures: Pre-recorded content with live Q&A.
- Choose-your-own-adventure presentations directed by audience voting.
- Storytelling to analyze and advance scenarios.

Workshops and Debates:

- Co-creation workshops for collaborative problem-solving.
- World Café format: Rotating thematic discussions.
- Oxford-style debates with audience involvement.
